

DISCLOSURE ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

Pursuant to Articles 13 and 14 of Regulation (EU) 679/2016, European Regulation for the protection of personal data (hereinafter also "the Regulation"), we hereby inform you that, in order to respond to your request to participate and book seats to take part in the activity or attend the event you are interested in promoted by CUBO Condividere Cultura, the Unipol Group Corporate Museum, Unipol Assicurazioni S.p.A. (hereinafter also "Unipol" or the "Data Controller") in its capacity as Data Controller, will process certain personal data, belonging to both common and special categories¹ (in particular, data relating to health status), that refer to you or to third parties (see below).

The personal data we process

The personal data processed (hereinafter referred to as "the Data"), in pursuance of the purpose set out below, are personal data (one's own first name, surname and those of any accompanying person), contact details (telephone/mobile phone number, email address) and data belonging to special categories (data relating to health status). We hereby inform you that your contact details may be used to provide you with confirmation of your booking and to send you further service communications (if necessary) relating to the activity you are interested in.

Processing purposes

The data will be processed exclusively for the purpose of enabling the booking of an event and the performance of the activity/activities, while providing assistance to persons with disabilities and reserving a dedicated seat for them. The legal basis is the need to perform a contract or a service you have requested. The processing of data related to your disability status can only take place with your explicit consent. Therefore, without it, it will not be possible to proceed with sending the seat reservation request.

Processing methods

The data shall be processed by means of procedures and methods, both computerised and electronic (including through the use of email and SMS, to acknowledge your request), relevant to the purpose pursued, in compliance with the security measures adopted and necessary to prevent compromise of the confidentiality, integrity and availability of the data.

The Data will be accessible to assigned personnel, who are instructed and authorised to carry out processing operations, to the extent strictly necessary for the performance of their functions.

The Data may be communicated, within the limits of what is strictly necessary for the pursuit of the aforesaid purpose, to third parties to which the Data Controller entrusts the performance of specific processing operations and with which it enters into agreements aimed at regulating the processing of personal data.

The data will not be disseminated.

Data retention terms

The data will be processed for the time strictly necessary for the booking and performance of activities, and, at the end of participation in the activity or event, the data will be deleted.

Right to provide data and consequences of refusal

The provision of data is necessary for the pursuit of the aforesaid purpose. Failure to provide the data therefore makes it impossible for the Data Controller to provide the requested service.

Rights of the Data Subject

We hereby remind you that the privacy legislation (Articles 15-22 of the Regulation) guarantees the data subject the right to access his/her data at any time, to request its rectification and/or supplementation, if inaccurate or incomplete, its deletion, if unlawfully processed, or to obtain the restriction of its processing, if the conditions are met, or to object to it for reasons related to the particular situation of the data subject. The Regulation also establishes the right to the portability of personal data provided by the data subject, if processed by automated means, on the basis of a contract or consent. We also remind you that you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time, without prejudice to the lawfulness of the processing carried out up to that point.

You retain the right to file a complaint with the Italian Data Protection Authority, if deemed necessary, to protect your personal data or any connected rights.

¹ Pursuant to Article 9 of the Regulation, special categories of data are personal data revealing racial or ethnic origin, political opinions, religious or philosophical beliefs, or trade union membership, genetic data, biometric data intended to uniquely identify a natural person, data concerning health or data concerning a natural person's sex life or sexual orientation. Pursuant to Article 4, point 1) of the Regulation, personal data (not belonging to special categories) are constituted by any information relating to a natural person, identified or identifiable, including indirectly, by reference to an identifier such as the name, an identification number, location data or an online identifier.

In order to submit your request, you must confirm that you have read the privacy policy.
