

DISCLOSURE ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA
(henceforth, "*Privacy Policy*")

Pursuant to Articles 13 and 14 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 - General Data Protection Regulation (hereinafter also the '**Regulation**'), we wish to inform you that, in pursuing the purposes set out below, we will process certain personal data that refers to you (and/or possibly third parties).

Who will process the personal data?

The data controller of your personal data is Unipol Assicurazioni S.p.A. (www.unipol.it), headquartered in Via Stalingrado 45 - 40128 Bologna (henceforth, "**Unipol**" or the "**Company**").

What personal data will be processed?

The following categories of personal data (hereinafter, also, the '**Data**' or '**Your Data**') will be processed:

- a) personal data voluntarily provided by you by filling out the form made available to you.

Why will we process your data?

The Data will be processed for the purposes and according to the legal bases detailed below:

- (F1) – *Management of information requests (hereinafter also the "Assistance Services" or the "Services")*: the processing takes place in order to respond to your request (i) for information and clarifications relating to the activities of CUBO Condividere Cultura – the corporate museum of the Unipol Group¹ or (ii) the booking of meeting rooms. The processing of data is therefore based on the need to provide feedback to your requests during a pre-contractual phase or to execute contractual obligations assumed by the Company towards you.

F1	a)	The legal basis of the processing is the need to provide a response to your requests during a pre-contractual phase or to execute the Company's contractual obligations towards you.	The provision of your data is necessary to pursue the indicated purpose; in case of failure to provide it, if the data is not provided, we will not be able to respond to your request.

How will we process your data?

The Data will be processed using rationales and methods, including computerised ones, strictly relevant to the purposes indicated above, after adopting security measures deemed adequate to the risks, and will be made accessible only to authorised and trained personnel, and only to the extent strictly necessary to carry out the activities they are required to perform.

To whom will we communicate the Data?

The Data will not be subject to disclosure, but may be communicated to third parties, where strictly necessary, for the sole purposes set out above. In particular, the Data may be communicated to:

- external parties to whom Unipol Assicurazioni S.p.A. entrusts the performance of activities on its behalf (by way of example, and not limited to, suppliers of IT and electronic services, etc.) and with whom it stipulates agreements aimed at regulating the processing of personal data;
- third parties, in compliance with an obligation established by law, by a regulation or by European legislation.

The Data will not be transferred to countries outside the European Union or the European Economic Area. If this is necessary to pursue the above purposes, we will do so based on the safeguards provided for in the Regulation, such as an adequacy decision by the European Commission, or the signing of standard contractual clauses with the data importer.

For how long will we process the Data?

The Data will be processed for the entire duration and until the conclusion of the event, as well as for the additional time necessary to pursue the purposes set out above:

In detail:

Objectives	Data retention terms
F1	For the time strictly necessary to process the request. If a fee is required for the booking and rental of spaces or meeting rooms, the personal data will be kept for administrative-accounting purposes, for the time established by sector regulations (in general, 10 years).

Your rights

The privacy law (articles 15 to 22 of the Regulation) guarantees you the right to access the Data at any time, to have them amended and/or supplemented if inaccurate or incomplete, deleted if processed unlawfully, and the portability of the data that you have provided to us, if processed automatically based on your consent or for the contractual services you have requested, within the limits established by the Regulation (article 20).

The privacy law also gives you the right to limit the processing of the Data if certain conditions are met, and to oppose to their processing for reasons connected with your particular circumstances.

The data protection officer is at your disposal for clarifications on the processing of the Data and the exercise of your rights: you can contact the data protection officer at the email address privacy@unipol.it.

Your right to contact the Data Protection Authority remains unaffected, which may include the filing of a complaint, where deemed necessary, to protect your data and your rights.
